## 3. Maintain the essay structure

Like any other type of argumentative essay, it has a formal structure everyone should keep to. It consists of an introduction, main body, and conclusion. Each of these paragraphs has its specifics. The central part of the introduction is a thesis statement, where you must show the main problem of your essay.

The body of your essay can consist of 2-3 paragraphs. Each body paragraph should be devoted to a separate argument. The number of paragraphs may depend on the given word count. If the word count is no less than 275 words, two sections of the main body are enough.

The conclusion is closely connected to the thesis statement. In your final paragraph, you should give a clear answer to the question stated in the introduction. If you have difficulties with the closing paragraph, maybe you have not fulfilled the purpose of your essay, and you should work more with your arguments.

## 4. Prove your point of view with facts

Strong argumentation is key to a successful essay. It is not enough to provide your thoughts. It would be best to use quotations from other scholars to give a worthy argumentation. You must stay away from your emotions and use a cold mind to complete this essay successfully.

Good research is the best way to gather concrete facts for your essay. If your professor gave you a

bibliography list, study it in the first place. Your evidence can be of different types. Gather statistical data, pick up relevant citations, and use conclusions from other papers on your topic to give as strong argumentation as possible.
