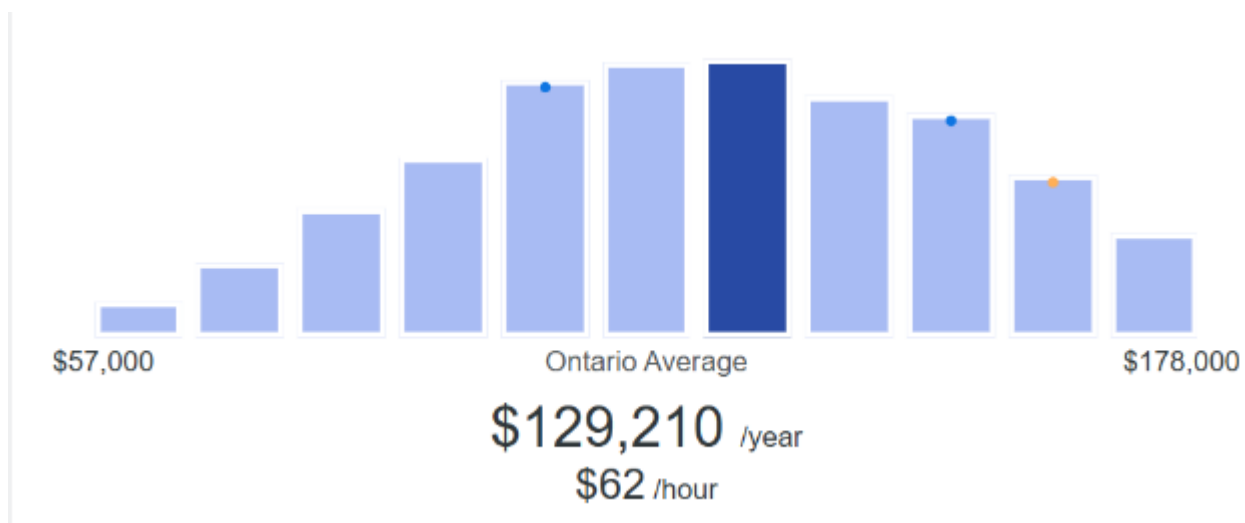


Figure 1: Average Salaries for Cloud Engineers in Ontario

Promotional Opportunities and Career Growth Plan

CISM: confirms cloud management abilities, necessary for advancement to senior positions

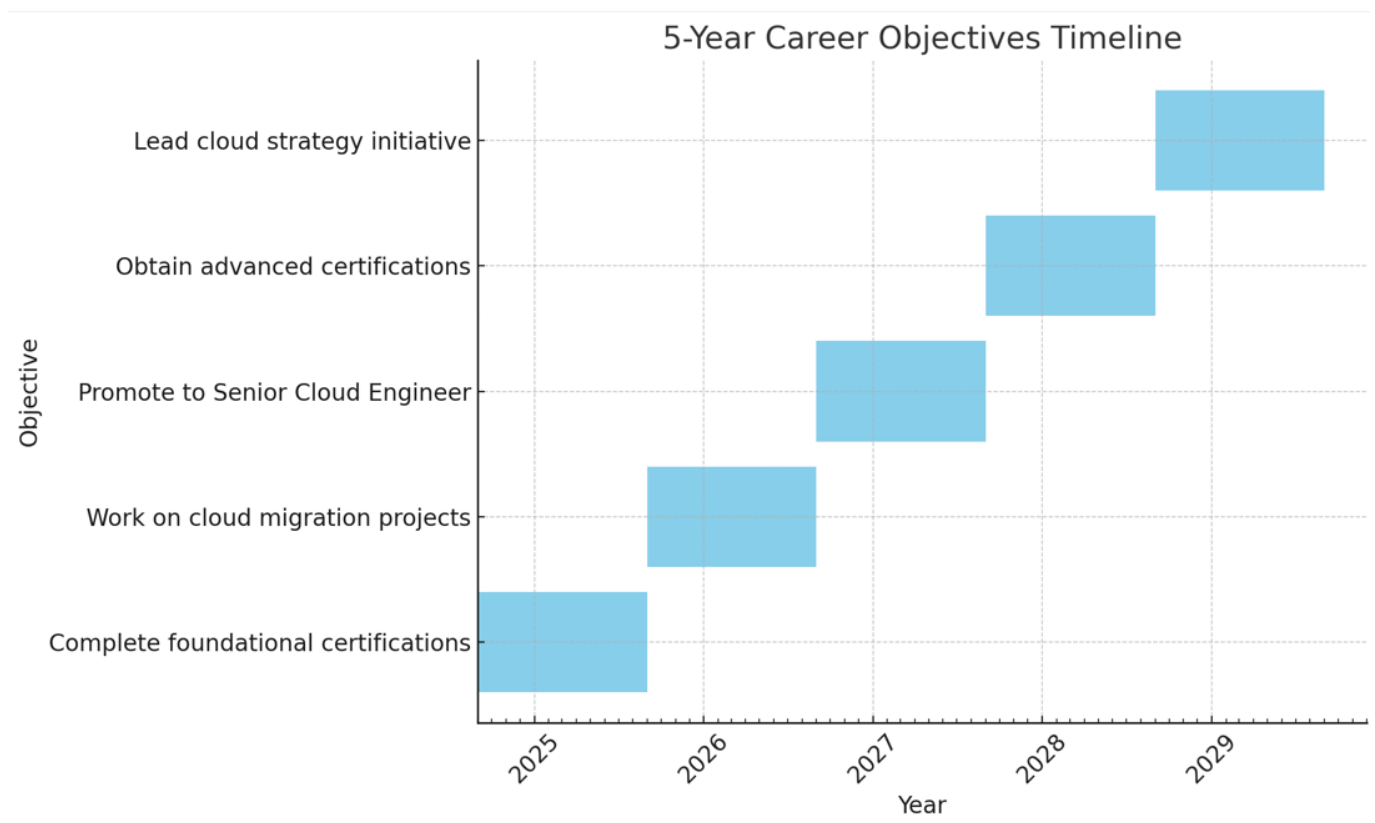


Figure 2: Gantt chart of career promotion timeline

Lastly, employment permit and visa issues may impede my job advancement, as managing regulations regarding immigration is unpredictable and takes time.

Strategies for overcoming Barriers:

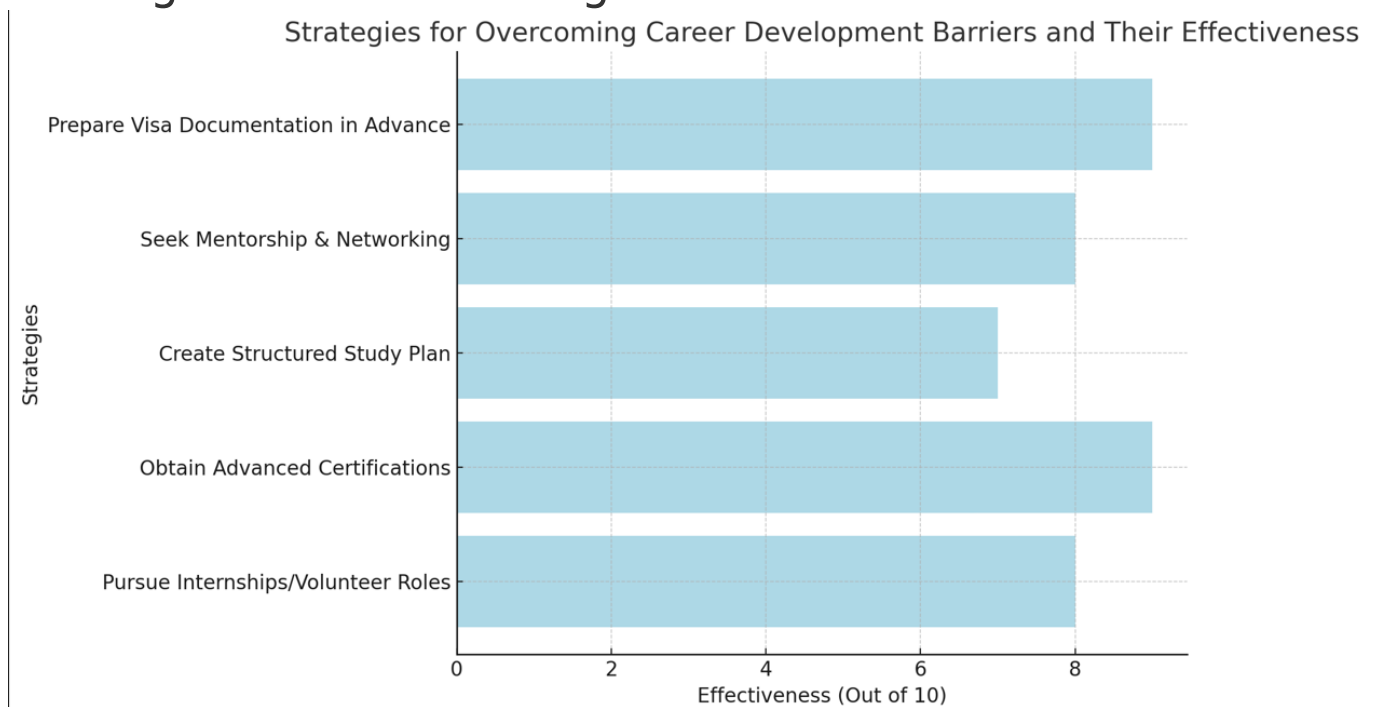


Figure 3: Strategies for overcoming potential barriers
