There are 10 unifying themes that have guided the development of the nursing programs at Western Governors University. These themes are depicted visually in the conceptual model below.

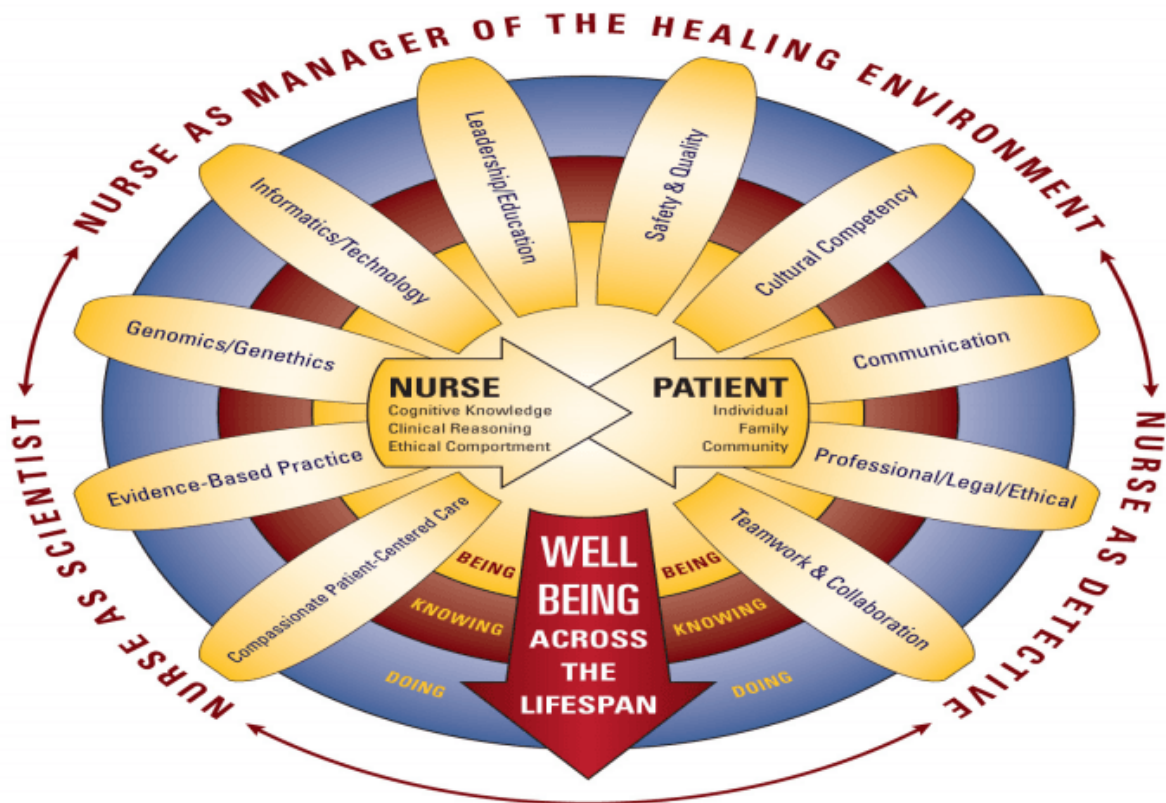


Figure 1-Conceptual Framework of Nursing Programs (Conceptual Framework of Nursing Programs at Western Governors University) (Western Governors University, n.d.)

Turning the patient every 2 hours, performing the skin assessments regularly, and providing good hygiene as necessary are examples of EBP to prevent hospital-acquired pressure ulcers. I remember that we had 89 years 89-year-old patient with dementia who was very fragile. When I was doing my full assessment, I noticed that she had redness in her coccyx area. By turning her every 2 hours and providing proper skincare, we were able to prevent her from having pressure ulcers before discharge.
